

Report of 10th FOGSI ICOG Annual Conference at Hotel Sheraton Grand, Pune, Maharashtra hosted by Pune Obstetrics and Gynaecological Society between March 1-2, 2025.

The 10th Annual Conference of FOGSI ICOG was successfully held at the Hotel Sheraton Grand, Pune, under the auspices of the Pune Ob-Gyn Society from March 1–2, 2025. It was named as 'Up2date in Ob-Gyn... Fundamental to Advanced' to encourage practitioners to stay current in their clinical practices & focused on fundamental to advanced topics.

- A moderator then facilitated an interactive dialogue for 15–18 minutes, ensuring a dynamic exchange of ideas.

This structured approach fostered deeper discussions, balanced viewpoints, and active participation, making the sessions more impactful and collaborative.
