**1. ICOG Convocation:** The ICOG Convocation was held on February 1, 2020 during the 63<sup>rd</sup> All India Congress of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. Dr. M. L. B. Bhat, Vice Chancellor, KGMU was the Chief Guest, Padmashree Dr. D. Y. Patil and Dr. Jacky Nizard, President EBCOG were the Guests of Honor, Dr. Edward Morris, President RCOG, Prof. Kazunori Ochiai, President AFOG and Dr. Alison Wright were conferred Honorary Fellowships. Total 9 ICOG Founder Fellows were felicitated with ICOG Ratna Samman Award for their life time services & devotion for ICOG namely Dr. Rohit Bhatt, Dr. Shirish Daftary, Dr. Shirish Sheth, Dr. Usha Krishna, Dr. Usha Saraiya, Dr. C. B. Purandare, Dr. Meera Agnihotri, Dr. Rangila Sinha and Dr. Raj Bhavaja. Total 210 new Fellows, 8 new Member were conferred the Fellowship and Membership of ICOG. Also 1 ICOG Emcure Pharma Travel Awardee, 6 Toppers of ICOG Certificate Course training exams in Reproductive Medicine, Gynaecological Endoscopy, USG of January and July 2019 batches were felicitated. New ICOG office bearers were installed as Dr. Mandakini Megh, Chairperson, Dr. Parul Kotdawala as Vice Chairperson and Dr. Parag Biniwale as Secretary.

**2. FOGSI-ICOG Dr. C. L. Jhaveri Endowment Symposium 2019:** FOGSI-ICOG Dr. C. L. Jhaveri Symposium was scheduled during 63<sup>rd</sup> AICOG at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh on January 31, 2020 from 2.00 p.m. to 3.30 p.m. Prof. Tushar Kar, Chairperson ICOG, Dr. Laxmi Shrikhande, Vice Chairperson, Dr. Parag Biniwale, Secretary and Vice President of FOGSI had chaired this session. Topic: "We for Stree. Safer. Stronger. Smarter". Speakers & their

**3. Combined MICOG-MRCOG Part 1 examine:** The MOU between FOGSI ICOG & RCOG had been renewed for Next three year ie.2019 to 2022 for conducting combined Part 1 & 2 MRCOG Courses as well as Examinations in India.

June 4-6, 2021: RCOG done online course for Part 1 candidates those enrolled with them due to Covid restriction.

July 5, 2021: MRCOG Part 1 examination will be done on digital platform by RCOG due to Covid restriction.

**4. MRCOG Part 2 examine:** January 19-21, 2021: 3<sup>rd</sup> Refresher course for MRCOG Part 2 exam was attended by 6 candidates at FOGSI office, Mumbai. Dr. R. Rajgopal, UK faculty and National Faculties were Dr. Sarita Bhalerao, Dr. Parikshit Tank, Dr. Anupama Dave, Dr. Latika Chawla and Dr. Siddesh Iyer etc. were conducted the course successfully. ICOG Officials Prof. Tushar Kar, Dr. Laxmi Shrikhande inaugurated the course.

February 3, 2020: MRCOG Part 2 examination was done at Kolkata and Mumbai centres.

Due to Covid 19 situation all over the World, RCOG had done Online Part 1 MRCOG Revision course centrally from the College on July 10-12, 2020. MRCOG Part 1 and 2 examinations have been postponed until 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September & conducted on digital platform.

June 4-6, 2021: RCOG done online course for Part 2 candidates those enrolled with them due to Covid restriction.

July 6, 2021: MRCOG Part 1 examination will be done on digital platform by RCOG due to Covid restriction.

RCOG are also running an additional Part 1 and 2 exam diet on 20 and 21 September 2021 to cater for any candidates who are not able to sit in July online.

**5. Combined MICOG-MRCPI Part 2 examine:** As MOU between FOGSI ICOG and MRCPI was due since 2018 and due to MCI recognition issue, RCPI is not ready to renew the MOU between us.

**6. Result of ICOG Election:** From 2019, ICOG has adopted Step Ladder System for Office Bearers election. Every two years, the elections will be held for Secretary & Governing Council member posts and every alternate year there will be an election for Vice chairperson elect. The election will be conducted electronically.

In 2020, 1<sup>st</sup> Online ICOG Election was conducted successfully for the posts of 1. ICOG Secretary (2021-22) & 2. Twenty Five Governing Council Members (2021-22) between 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020 at 10.00 am to 10<sup>th</sup> August at 5.00 pm. Percentage of voting was 72.83 %. Great efforts has taken by Dr Jaydeep Tank , Secretary General FOGSI, for putting election process together, under the leadership of Dr. Alpesh Gandhi President FOGSI, Dr. Mandakini Megh Chairperson ICOG. FOGSI ICOG National Conference on NCD was held between Feb 4-7, 2021 with Mumbai Ob-Gyn Society which was 1<sup>st</sup> virtual conference in the history of ICOG & FOGSI. Dr. Alpesh Gandhi, President FOGSI, Dr. Mandakini Megh, Chairperson ICOG and Dr. Rishma Dhillon Pai were the Conference Organizers. It was mega conference successfully conducted & attended by more than 3500 members with 400 national & international faculties. It was endorsed by FIGO, SAFOG, AICC RCOG, World NCD Federation, MWIA, AMWI and Govt. of Maharashtra. It has given 20 ICOG credit points and 4 MMC points. There were two main halls named as Dr. C S Dawn & Dr. C L Jhaveri halls and beautiful layout of the virtual conference made by Onference Team. The message from President of FOGSI Dr. Alpesh Gandhi, Chairperson of ICOG, & President of Mumbai Dr. Rishma Dhillon Pai played continuously. 


